What to do in case of COVID-19

Symptomatic student at school.

- 1) School operators alert COVID-19 referent.
- 2) COVID-19 referent calls parents. The student waits in a safe separate area, wearing a surgical mask, assisted by a school operator, himself wearing a surgical mask or protection devices.
- 3) All the surfaces of the area or isolation room must be cleaned and sanitized after the symptomatic student leaves school to go back home.
- 4) Once at home, and in the following days, parents must contact and keep in touch with pediatrician/family doctors for they decide the real clinic evaluation of the case.
- 5) Pediatrician/ family doctor promptly requires the diagnostic test and communicates with Department of Prevention (ASL).
- 6) Department of Prevention (ASL) is in charge of execution of the diagnostic swab.

Symptomatic student at home.

- 1) The student must stay at home.
- 2) Parents must promptly inform their pediatrician/ family doctor.
- 3) Parents must notify the school the absence for health reasons.
- 4) Pediatrician/ family doctor promptly requires the diagnostic test and communicates with the Department of Prevention (ASL).
- 5) Department of Prevention (ASL) is in charge of execution of the diagnostic swab.
